**2. Which "*nothing is too difficult for You (God)*" example is your favorite? Why or what part of that connects with a life situation you can share?**

- Gen. 18:14 The promised birth of Isaac to the geriatrics
- Jer. 32:17, 27 God judging and then restoring his wayward people
- Luke 1:37 God birthing His Son through a virgin
- Luke 18:27 God saving people who could not possibly save themselves

**3. God demonstrates absolute power and authority over people and spiritual beings.**

- Do you have "people fears?"  
In what situations and how can you resolve them?
- Can you share an experience when Rom. 8:31 or Heb. 13:6 was especially meaningful?
- Review Hebrews 13:5-6 and discuss how our "money fears" may reveal either a puny view of God or an inflated (idolatrous) view of money.

**4. God shows total mastery of life and death.**

- Can you share an experience when God's mastery over death gave you a sense of peace/comfort?
- **Agree/Disagree/Discuss/Rant:**
  - *If your god will settle for anything less than everything he's not God Almighty!*
  - *Your life will testify to how big your God is.*

**Apply:** When we call on the name of the Lord...

Remember He has the power to do anything He pleases.

- **God's power is described as the source of all power.**

- All power belongs to God. Psalm 62:11; Rev. 19:1
- All power is dependent upon God's empowerment. John 15:5;

**Apply:** When we have needs...

#### 2. God's Power Exemplified

- **God shows unlimited power over creation.** Romans 1:20

God created everything from nothing just by speaking. Gen. 1:1; Rm. 4:17

**Apply:** Go glimpse a hint of the immensity and intensity of God's power.

Ask: Is my God big enough for my need?

- **God shows absolute power over created beings.**

Isaiah 40; Romans 8:31; Daniel 4; Hebrews 1:6-7; Revelation 20:10

**Apply:** Whom shall I fear? Heb. 13:6; Rev. 1:17 & Matt. 10:28

- **God shows total mastery of life and death.**

Matt. 28:5-6; Romans 1:4; John 5:25-29

**Challenge:** Repent and run from mini-gods to worship and serve the King!
