**We must consider one another to \_\_\_\_\_.**

## Considering One Another

*Considering how to stimulate **one another** to love and good deeds.*

Hebrews 10:24 in Context

### We must **consider one another** to **remain faithful**.

- in our worship: *Draw near...*
- in our witness: *...the confession of our faith...*
- in our work: *...to love and good deeds...*

### Considerations:

#### 1. **Consider one another** is a key command from God.

- It is the imperative here.  
“Look” + down = to look intently
- It is consistent with God’s priorities stated elsewhere.  
1) Love God + 2) Love others = 1 and 2 and “all the Law and Prophets!”

#### 2. **Consider one another** is fundamental to our call to faithfulness.

- The chain of commands indicates authorial intent. “Let us:”  
*Draw near, 22; Hold fast, 23; Consider one another, 24*  
This link in the chain holds up the following context
- This final link in the command chain holds us back from...
  - *...forsaking the assembling* 25
  - *...sinning willfully!* 26ff.

- This command is built on a textual foundation.  
*Since we have...the blood...a new & living way...a great high priest...*
- This text is consistent with the rest of the book.  
See 3:1-14 with the shared terminology...  
*consider, High Priest, our confession, faithful, hold fast, encourage **one another***  
...and a metaphor of together.  
*The household of God*

#### 4. **Consider one another** is integral to our created nature.

- Alone is “not good.” Genesis 1-2
- Two are better. Ecclesiastes 4:9-12
